Sub: Payment of affiliation fee for the academic year 2008-09- Certain clarification

Sir,

The Principals of a few affiliated colleges are enquiring about the payment of affiliation fee for the academic year 2008-09 as per the communication they have received from JNTUH regarding balance amount due to them.

In this context, it is clarified that during the commencement of the academic year 2008-09 the erstwhile JNTU has given temporary affiliation to all the affiliated colleges. As such certain amount has already been paid towards inspection fee and application cost etc., It is noticed that affiliation fee of Rs. 150/- per candidate has to be paid to the Registrar, JNTUH.

Therefore it is clarified that for the academic year 2008-09, affiliation fee pending to JNTUH may please be paid direct to the Registrar, JNTUH.

However the Registration Fee of Rs. 2500/- per candidate has to be paid at JNTUK for the academic year 2008-09. It is informed that most of the colleges have paid the registration fee to JNTUK and obtained Clearance Certificate from this office. The details are furnished in the University Web Page. However, some colleges did not submit their applications/ fee etc., and some did not produce their Original Certificates for verification.

Therefore, all the Principals of the affiliated colleges who were not issued Clearance Certificates for any of the reasons mentioned above are here by directed to take necessary steps immediately, failing which they would attract a fine of Rs. 1.0 Lakh for delay beyond 16.04.2009.
