



Memorandum of Understanding between

M/s. Consortium of Institutions of Higher Learning and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Kakinada

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered on 4th April 2012 between M/s. Consortium of Institutions of Higher Learning (herein after referred as CIHL),

AND

Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Kakinada (herein after referred as JNTUK).

Background

1. CIHL is involved in running an innovative inter-disciplinary postgraduate program in Information Technology, called "Master of Science in Information Technology" (MSIT)
2. JNTUK has been deemed an autonomous one after Act No.30 of the approval of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature known as the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological Universities Act, 2008 which came into force on 18th August, 2008. It is a teaching cum research oriented university consisting of the constituent and affiliated colleges.
3. Now both the parties have proposed to execute this MoU, to be effective from date 04.04.2012, (academic year 2012 - 2013) reflecting the parties understanding as of that date.

Terms and Conditions of MoU

JNTUK and CIHL agree to the Terms mentioned below.

1. CIHL conducts the admission process of MSIT students for the course at JNTUK. This process includes issue of admission notification every year, arranging admission tests, counseling and selection of students for admission into MSIT course at JNTUK.
2. JNTUK agrees to run the MSIT programme in computer science programme and will provide a faculty member as a MSIT coordinator CIHL's contribution would be in the form of content development, delivery and faculty resources.
3. JNTUK and CIHL agree to co-operate with each other in research and other activities for furtherance of the MSIT programme.
4. CIHL and JNTUK agree to cooperate to develop the standards and process relating to admissions, curriculum, teaching, evaluation, recruitment and training of faculty and mentors, project work and other key aspects of the program.
5. JNTUK and CIHL agree to implement the programme with Learning by doing methodology and with Project Centered curriculum.
6. Necessary Infrastructure must be provided by JNTUK as required by the program.



7. The degree at the end of the MSIT program would be awarded by JNTUK.

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8. Course fee will be collected by CIHL at the rates as decided by CIHL and will remit share of fee to JNTUK i.e. 25% of the fee so collected by CIHL from the each student, to meet the administrative and academic expenditure by JNTUK in running the programme at JNTUK. JNTUK will assist CIHL in collecting the fee from MSIT students at JNTUK.
9. The degree awarded to the students at JNTUK would be considered as equivalent to the corresponding degree awarded by JNTUK and would be given transfer credits for the courses taken up to the maximum permitted by the JNTUK rules.
10. Participation by the parties to this MoU shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and approval of each institution.
11. This MoU will have effect from 04th day of April, 2012 and valid till October, 2017. It can be extended for an additional period on mutually agreed terms.
12. This MOU is entered between CIHL and JNTUK in the presence of principal college of engineering and HOD of Computer Science Department.
