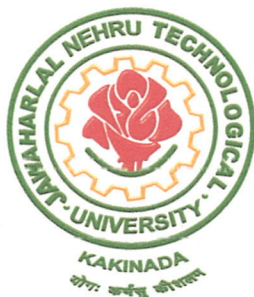


ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOR MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION PROGRAMS

BETWEEN:

JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA
Kakinada- 533 003. Andhra Pradesh, India
(herein referred to as “JNTUK”)



and

UNIVERSITY CANADA WEST, CANADA
(herein referred to as the “UCW”)



A. BACKGROUND

- A.1 JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA is a university operating in India with full authority to award Master of Business Administration degrees.
- A.2 UNIVERSITY OF CANADA is a private, provincially approved, degree granting university operating at 1111 Melville St., Vancouver, British Columbia
- A.3 JNTUK offers to its students Master of Business Administration degree (herein referred to as the "JNTUK Program") and is empowered to grant degrees to the graduates of the "JNTUK Program".
- A.4 UNIVERSITY CANADA WEST offers a Masters of Business Administration (herein referred to as the "UCW Program") and is empowered to grant degrees to the graduates of the "UCW Program".

B. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this Agreements include, but are not limited to :

- B.1 Ensuring access to students of the JNTUK Program to the University Program. Schedule "A"
- B.2 Establishment of criteria to determine eligibility of JNTUK students and graduates to the UCW Program.
- B.3 Recognize certain courses taken at JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA – for transfer credit to the UCW program for those students who do not complete the JNTUK program. Schedule "A"
- B.4 Tuition cost and cost saving for JNTUK students.

C. AGREEMENT

- C.1 The University Canada West agrees to accept in the UCW Program, JNTUK students of the JNTUK Program who meet the criteria set out in Schedule "A" of this Agreement.
- C.2 Transfer credit will be given on a specific course basis for the courses specified in Schedule "B" for students who have taken some but not all of the JNTUK MBA program courses.
- C.3 Both JNTUK and University Canada West agree to encourage JNTUK students to participate in this articulation program by providing information and assistant to prospective transfer students.

- C.4 Both JNTUK and University Canada West will designate a Program Representative at their respective campuses to facilitate co-ordination of this agreement.

D. TERM OF AGREEMENT

- D.1 This Agreement will become effective on March 16, 2011, and shall have a term of TWO years, automatically renewable thereafter on a year to year basis unless at least twelve (12) month's notice of termination in writing is provided by either party to the other.
- D.2 In the event of the termination of this Agreement under Section D.1. both parties acknowledge and agree that, subject to the qualification requirements set out in Schedule "A", all students enrolled in the JNTUK Program as at the date of such termination shall be entitled to admission to the UCW Program under this Agreement despite its termination so as to ensure the fulfillment of the reasonable expectations of such students.
- D.3 Each institution must inform the other if substantive changes in curriculum (greater than 20%) are being considered.
- D.4 Both Universities will explore the possibility of joint research project (s) with the involvement of their faculty as well as research scholars for the mutual benefit.
- D.5 Both Universities will undertake joint corporate consultancy and training programs in India. It will be the endeavor of both the institutions to engage students to have real and live corporate experience while doing their Master's program.
- D.6 UCW will extend full support and cooperation to JNTUK for need based Faculty Development Programs at Kakinada at reasonable cost.

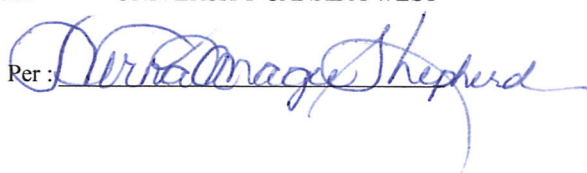

Program Learning Outcomes

This program will:

1. Recognize students of the Masters degree program in Business Administration at JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA
2. Provide a Masters level program in Business Administration for JNTU degree students at UCW
3. Meet UCW Master of Business Administration Degree graduation requirements
4. Enable completion of the MBA in one additional year following graduation for the JNTUK MBA degree program.

Admission Requirements

1. Successful completion of the JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA – General Master of Business Administration Degree 1st year courses (Semester 1 and Semester 2).
2. GPA of '50%' or better in the JNTUK program, with no specific course grade less than 50%.
3. Proven satisfactory performance on the approved measures of English Language proficiency. (See language requirements below.)

Language Requirement

English is the language of instruction and communication. International applicants whose first language is not English are expected to have the equivalent of a Canadian high school (Grade 12) diploma. If English is not the student's first language, the student will need to provide evidence of competency in English.

- **International English Language Testing Services (IELTS) : 6.5**

Campus Study

This program is specifically applicable to study on campus in Canada at the UCW campus in Vancouver B.C. A student can elect to complete their program of course work on campus, in one year over five terms of 10-weeks per term. In some cases, a student might require additional time to complete the work for MBA – 522 Consulting / Research Project.

To qualify for credit, the student must have earned a grade of 50% or higher in the **JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA Courses.**

Schedule B

Tuition Cost for Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada Students at University Canada West.

Each of the University Canada West Masters of Business Administration (MBA) courses consist of 3 credit hours and costs \$ 2,160 Canadian Dollars.

The total cost of the entire MBA program with 16 courses worth 48 credit hours at UCW is \$ 34,560 Canadian Dollars.

Through this articulation agreement, students of JNTUK, Kakinada having met the requirements of entrance to UCW's MBA program, must complete a total of 11 courses in order to graduate at the MBA level from UCW.

The total cost for completing 11 courses worth 33 credit hours is \$ 23,760 Canadian Dollars.

This is a total cost saving of \$ 10,800 Canadian Dollars for the students of JNTUK, Kakinada.
