

Memorandum of Cooperation

Between

Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada

&

SIIE Foundation Hyderabad

For coordinating admission of Foreign Students in JNTU Kakinada

Memorandum of Cooperation (Amended)

This Memorandum of Co-operation agreement has been entered into between two parties.

Party I: Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada (JNTUK, Kakinada), Andhra Pradesh, India-533003, hereafter referred to as **"the Institution"**

and

Party II: Social Health Educational Awareness Foundation (SHE Foundation, Hyderabad), 503, SVS Papaiah Estates, Chikkadapally, Hyderabad- 500020, Andhra Pradesh, India, a Trust . Registered at Hyderabad, A.P. hereafter referred to as **"the Trust"**.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

Based on mutual understanding, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada(JNTUK), Kakinada and the SHE Foundation, Hyderabad agree to the following with reference to admission of all students in 5 year IIMDP and other UG and PG Programs conducted jointly by Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok, Thailand and USFA, USA with JNTUK, Kakinada, India.

The above is also applicable to Students belonging to the category of NRI/PIO/Foreign Nationals in any UG/PG/PhD/Training/Certificate Programs or any International educational programs conducted by JNTUK, Kakinada, India, provided the student is admitted through SHE Foundation.

1.1 In order to support JNTUK students applying or admitted to the Institution, the Trust will assist in various matters and offers professional services such as

i) Expert advice for residence permit, travel arrangements, banking issues, housing application etc. in Kakinada as well as Bangkok or USA.

ii) Offer other programs:-

a) Orientation / Motivation Sessions and Induction Training for Two weeks for freshers of UG and IIMDP Programs.

b) Project Management and facilitating industrial tours.

c) Advertisement through Brochures, websites, National and International education fairs, and through Print and electronic media.

d) Counseling Programs to aspiring students during admission process of JNTUK-AIT/USFA collaborated Programs with regular correspondence between JNTUK and SHE Foundation.

e) Sponsoring 50% of the expenditure of the visit of Two faculty from JNTUK to AIT and Two faculty of AIT to JNTUK for a period of maximum one week per each financial year. The sponsorship includes Hospitality like lodging and boarding only but not Airfare, transport and Honorarium.

f) Facilitating and sponsoring the teaching of any Two courses (Subjects) in one of the two semesters in first year. This is done by a guest faculty who completes the course in a few weeks in consultation with the university.

g) Appoint One Person to coordinate these activities of JNTUK-AIT/USFA and assist the students concerned. JNTUK will provide office space for this person to work.

1.2 JNTUK will charge an additional fee equivalent to 6.25% of total tuition fee from every student enrolled in JNTUK-AIT/USFA collaborated programs every year. However, the amount equivalent to 6.25% of total tuition fee for entire JNTUK-AIT/USFA collaborated program will be paid to SHE Foundation for their services, (annually or instalment-wise, as the case may be) after completion of the admission process of the JNTUK-AIT/USFA collaborated programs. (For Example, if the annual tuition fee for IIMDP is Rs. 212,500/-, JNTUK will pay Rs. 12,500 per student annually to SHE Foundation. Similarly, if JNTUK collects Rs. 750,000/- as first instalment of total fee of Rs. 2500,000/- for the Aviation Engineering course with USFA, it will pay Rs. 44,118/- per student (6.25% of 705,882) to SHE Foundation as first instalment. The Total amount paid to SHE Foundation by JNTUK will be 6.25% of 23.53 lakhs, that is, about Rs. 1.47 lakhs per student admitted into 4-year Aviation Engineering with USFA, as total fee charged by JNTUK from each student is Rs. 25 lakhs for four years.

The same process will be applicable between JNTUK and SHE Foundation for Students of category NRI/Pol/Foreign Nationals admitted through SHE Foundation in JNTUK for any of its UG/PG/PhD/Training Programs. SHE Foundation will strive for admission of students from a minimum of 10 different countries by 2014. SHE Foundation will also assist JNTUK in establishing collaborations with Universities in Asia, CIS, Europe, Russia, Australia, Africa, North America and South America and others.

1.3 The agreement contained within it will be valid until 30 July 2021. Both the parties mutually can go for any additional agreements or protocols in case of updations of this agreement.

1.4 Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with this contract, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be finally settled in the jurisdiction of Kakinada court.
