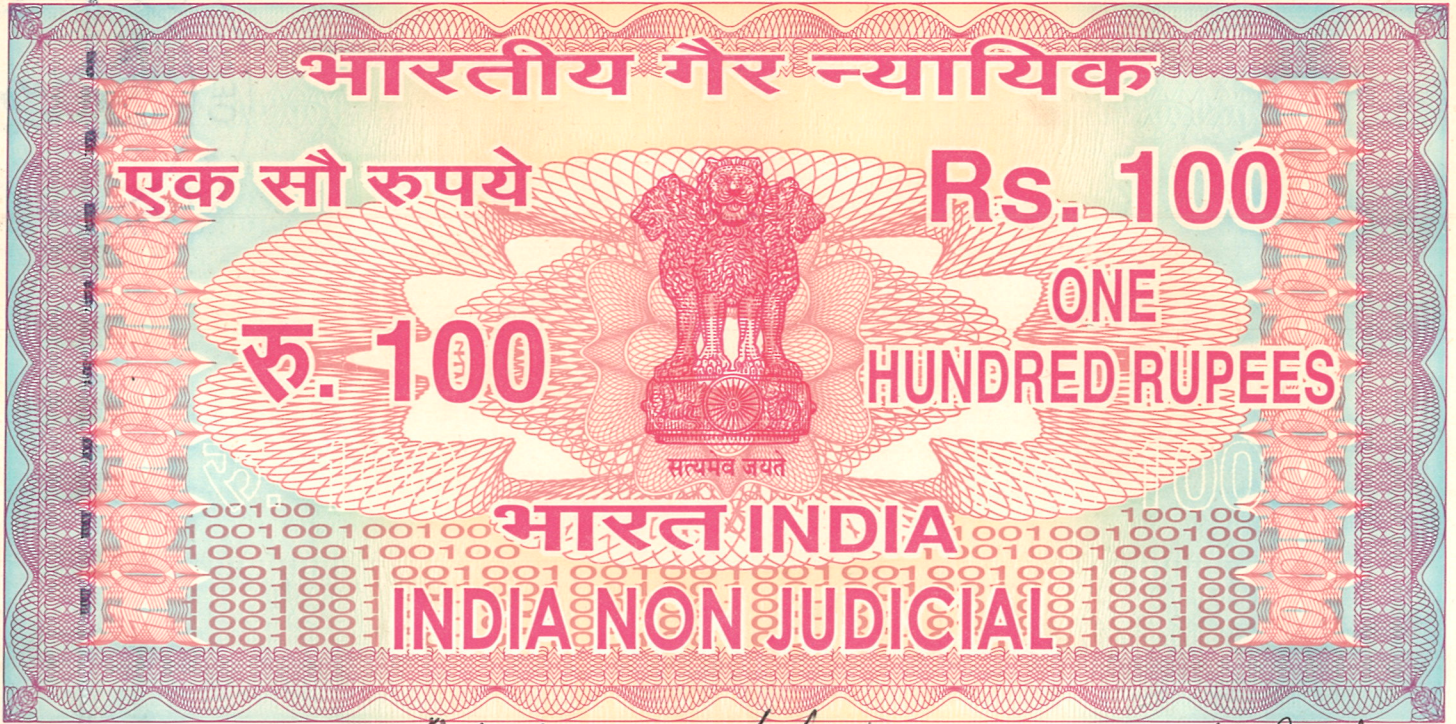

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Subject of Cooperation: Promoting cooperation for the development of friendly institutional relations.

This memorandum of understanding (hereinafter called "MoU") has been made and entered into on the day of **16th June, 2018** by and between:

EAST GODAVARI DISTRICT, ANDHRA PRADESH, INDIA

Here in represented by **Prof. Pulapa Subba Rao**, in his capacity as **Vice-Chancellor of Millennium University** approved by the Council of Millennium University, Blantyre, Malawi.

PREAMBLE:

This MoU is with a view to enhancing cooperation between Republic of India and the Republic of Malawi, and to promote the development of friendly institutional relations, **JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA (JNTUK), Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh, India and Millennium University, Blantyre, Malawi** hereafter referred to as "The Parties":

Article 1

Have identified issues of common interest for cooperation such as

- Joint Academic Activities like Staff Development, Curriculum Revision & Development, and Research & Publications
- Staff Exchange; and
- Student Exchange

Article 2

ACADEMIC STAFF RELATIONS

Cooperation under this Memorandum shall include:

1. Academic staff members of each institution will share information, experience, and expertise in developing academic curricula in the areas of Business and Management, Human Resource Management, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Social work, Economics, Public Sector Management, Business Information Technology, E-Commerce and other areas of common interest.
2. Academic staff members of each University will explore areas of joint research interests and projects.

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3. For teaching collaborations, academic staff members will exchange pedagogical knowledge and information.
4. Academic staff members of both Universities would explore opportunities in jointly publishing in international journals and editing international research journals, hosting of research conferences, and conducting executive education workshops.
5. Millennium University, Malawi will meet the expenditure of the faculty invited from the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Kakinada including airfare (economy). Further, when the faculty of Millennium University, Malawi visits the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Kakinada, the expenditure incurred will be met by the Millennium University, Malawi and there shall be no financial commitment on the part of Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada.
6. Other forms of cooperation agreed upon by both parties through consultations.

Article 3

STUDENT EXCHANGE

1. Millennium University, Malawi will send up to Ten Bachelor students and MBA students under students' exchange program to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Kakinada. Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Kakinada will provide a list of courses to be offered during the academic semesters. Similarly, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Kakinada can send an equal number of students for two semesters under this exchange program to any of the educational programs being offered at Millennium University, Malawi.
2. Each party will be responsible for the selection of students to participate in the exchange program each year, and will address them to the host institution.
3. Candidates shall meet the following requirements:
 - a. Excellent academic background
 - b. Excellent command of the language of instruction (i.e., English) for their integration in to the selected curriculum
 - c. Maturity and ability to adapt to a foreign environment
 - d. Strong motivation for the academic program offered by the host institution

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4. The students will pay tuition fees at the prevailing international students' rates to the host University.
5. All expenses that include air fare, local travel, and accommodation will be borne by the students of the sponsoring University.

Article 4

Other issues not covered in this Memorandum shall be decided through mutual consultation between the parties.

Article 5

The Memorandum shall come into effect from 2018-19 academic year and shall be valid for five years. At the end of this period, it shall be automatically renewed for another five years, unless subject to modification by mutual agreement whenever necessary.

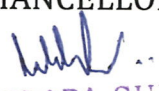
