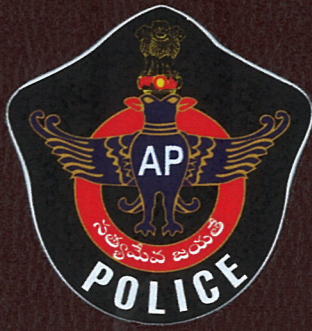

Preamble:

This MOU establishes a collaborative framework between JNTU, Kakinada and the A.P Police, Mangalagiri. With regard to offering specialized certificate course for a period of 9 months on **Cyber Crime** to the Police Constables (Civil & APSP). The aim of the training is to equip law enforcement personnel with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively combat and investigate cyber crime.

Objectives:

1. To deliver a comprehensive **9 months Certificate Course** to police officers covering the fundamentals and advanced techniques in Cyber Crime investigation and forensics.
2. To provide a multi-level certification path for police officers, ensuring progressive learning from basic concepts to advanced cybercrime investigations and constant skill upgradation in cyber domain and emerging technology.
3. To foster collaboration between JNTU, Kakinada and A.P Police Training Wing, AP, Mangalagiri in the field of Cyber Crime and Cyber security.
4. To enhance the overall competency of law enforcement officers in handling cyber crime cases.
5. To expand the collaboration to other knowledge domain and overall force of the police department.

Program Overview:

The program is designed as a **One-level certification course**:

The 9-Month Certificate Course will include:

- MS Office; Cyber Laws and (IT Act)
- Basics of Networking & Operating Systems
- Digital Evidence Handling
- Cyber Forensics Tools & Techniques
- OSINT & Dark Web Investigation
- Mobile Forensics
- Financial Fraud Investigation
- Cyber Threat Intelligence
- Practical Case Studies & Project Work

Mode of Delivery:

- A combination of online modules and classroom sessions.
- Valuation of Assessments, Practicals & Final Written examination.

After completion of these above course academic tenure, the participants i.e. Civil Police Constables and APSP Constables will receive finally a **Course Certificate** in Cyber Crime Investigation and Forensic.

Responsibilities of the Parties**JNTU, Kakinada, (Academic Partner) :**

1. Design and develop curriculum and content in consultation with domain experts.
2. Provide qualified faculty/resource persons.
3. Facilitate access to simulation labs and digital learning resources
4. Conduct assessments and issue certificates.

A.P Police Training Centers, (Training Partner):

1. Identify and enroll eligible police officers for the program.
2. Facilitate the necessary logistics i.e. online platforms and classroom sessions.
3. Ensure participation and timely completion of the course by enrolled officers.
4. Co-ordinate with the trainers and faculty from JNTU, Kakinada.

Confidentiality and Intellectual Property:

1. Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding any proprietary information shared during the collaboration.
2. All intellectual property generated during the course development will remain the property of the institution responsible for its creation, unless otherwise agreed upon in writing.

Financial Arrangements:

The fee structure, honorarium, and cost- sharing details shall be decided mutually through a separate annexure approved by both parties.

Duration of the MoU:

This MoU will remain valid for three (3) years from the date of signing and may be renewed with mutual consent.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this MoU by giving 90 days' written notice. However, ongoing batches shall be allowed to complete their training.

Dispute Resolution:

Any dispute arising out of this MoU shall be resolved amicably. If unresolved, it shall be referred to higher authorities of both parties for suitable resolution.

Miscellaneous

- Both institutions agree to maintain academic integrity and transparency.
- Intellectual Property generated under this collaboration will be jointly owned.
