

Memorandum of Understanding

And

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed on 11th September 2019 between Andhra Pradesh Police herein after referred to as AP Police and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh, herein after referred to as JNTU Kakinada.

Whereas Andhra Pradesh Police Department is the official Law Enforcing Agency of Andhra Pradesh formed on 1st November 1956. It is headed by the Director General of Police and the present Police headquarters is at Mangalagiri.

Whereas the JNTU Kakinada is established under JNTU act in 2008 and accredited by University Grants Commission (UGC). It is one of the leading educational university in the State of AP which focuses in the field of Engineering and Technology. All the professional colleges in eight districts have been affiliated under jurisdiction of JNTUK University.

Objective

The objective of this MoU between JNTU Kakinada and AP Police is to offer an "Internship Programme to address societal issues by inculcating social responsibilities in the B.Tech student fraternity. This MoU encompasses all the students of the constituent as well as the affiliated colleges of JNTUK Kakinada.

Terms of MoU

The MoU will promote social responsibilities among the students by paving a new dimension of collaboration.

The topics to be included in the social responsibility area are:

- Disaster Management
- Rescue home administration
- Road safety management
- Suicides among youth

One mini project is mandatory for undergraduate students of JNTUK as per their curriculum. Interested students of JNTUK may opt for either mini project or summer internship with Internship Organization in the mentioned topics.

JNTUK Responsibilities:

- JNTUK will select the qualified students for the internship / mini project.
- JNTUK will design the courses / curriculum for the internship / mini project.
- JNTUK will extend the necessary support to carry out the joint Research and Development in social awareness programs.
- JNTUK will award the grades for the students on successful completion of the course.
- The following staff member is responsible for serving as a single point of contact.

Police Department Responsibilities:

- Police department will expose students to the areas of social responsibility and related ethics.
- Police department shall provide possible opportunities to learn and understand with real time examples.

Student Responsibilities:

- Students will work on projects as directed by the staff of the Internship Organization.
- Student will report to the Internship Organization as directed by the Internship Organization.
- Student will abide by the administrative policies of the Internship Organization, including confidentiality policies and personnel practices.
- Student agrees to abide by the JNTU Kakinada Code of Student Conduct and any other JNTU Kakinada departmental or program policies relating to professional behaviour.
- The student should not disclose or divulge any confidential information which is not generally available to the public over the course of the programme.

Relationship of the Parties:

- Nothing in the MoU shall create an employment relationship, agency relation, joint venture, partnership between JNTUK and AP Police Department.
- Police department and JNTUK shall exchange no money, no assets, no costs and charge no fees in connection with the MoU.
- Student will be neither be an employee of the Police department and nor entitled to any benefits from police department.

Arbitration:

Any dispute or differences arising out of the interpretation of any of the clauses listed shall be resolved by mutual consultation and if any role of arbitration is needed, the matter shall be referred to the DGP, AP Police and Vice Chancellor of JNTU Kakinada, and their decision shall be binding on all the parties to this MoU.



DURATION, AMENDMENT & TERMINATION OF THE MOU:

This agreement will be in effect initially for the period of three years from the date of signing of this MoU by both the parties and will be renewed further if mutually agreed. Either party may terminate the MoU by a written notification signed by the appropriate official of the Institution initiating the notice. Such notice must be received by the other party Six months prior to the effective termination date. However, Obligations and commitments already agreed for and involving their parties shall be honoured and continued by both parties until such commitment is completed.

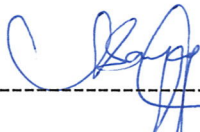
Terms and Conditions:

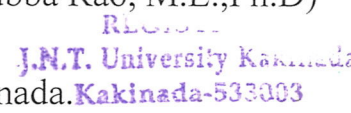

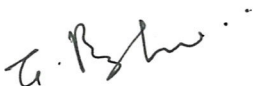
