MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY KAKINADA(Referred to as "JNTUK")

&

U.S. Flight Academy International of USA (Referred to as "USFA")

This Memorandum of Understanding between JNTUK and USFA records outline heads of agreement for the purpose of facilitating collaborative activity and academic links, made possible by the She Foundation. This MoU sets out a framework of principles and the parties agree that they will work together in a spirit of cooperation to achieve the purposes set out herein. This MoU is non-exclusive in nature; it does not preclude either party entering into any form of agreement with other institutions.

JNTUK and USFA will work together to offer a **4-Year Dual Degree in the field of Aviation Engineering** including Private Pilot, Commercial Pilot - Single and Multi-Engine Land with Instrument Privileges, Certified Flight Instructor Airplane and Instrument, and Certified Ground Instructor Advanced and Instrument.

USFA and JNTUK can also extend the facility through its project director She Foundation to JNTUK affiliated colleges as well as USFA associated institutions, wherever possible.

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this MoU is:

1.1 To encourage collaborative activity and a joint delivery of the various UG and PG level aviation engineering courses in the near future.

1.2 To facilitate the possibility of direct entry to the Commercial Pilot Program and other courses offered at USFA for JNTUK campus and JNTUK affiliated colleges and USFA Associated Colleges like Howard College and Utah Valley University.

1.3 This degree design is a result of cooperation between JNTUK University and USFA, and is prompted by the high number of qualified pilot applicants required in the expanding Aviation industry.

1.4 The global Aviation industry is expected to increase for the next five decades, and both JNTUK University and USFA feel that such a relationship will enhance and benefit the need of the Industry, as the end product, the student, will be superbly prepared for the challenges and cockpits of tomorrow.

1.5 This relationship will also strengthen each institution as each is drawing on others' strengths: The USFA has been providing successful flight training as an institution for 23 years, and the JNTUK University has been providing successful upper level academic training as an institution since 1946, and together they will have the prospects of shaping the aviation training industry as a leader, where their relationship can set the standards for civil pilot training and Aviation Engineering.

2. CONTEXT AND CONDITIONS

2.1 JNTUK will recruit a cohort of students and the student numbers as agreed.

2.2 JNTUK will advise on any of their affiliated colleges willing to be part of this arrangement in consultation with USFA and its project director She Foundation subsequently signing into a tripartite MoU.

3. INTENTION

3.1 It is the intention of both parties to this MoU that they will work positively and constructively together in relation to encouraging the development of collaborative activity.

3.2 The parties recognise as paramount the interest of students on all the programmes of study.

4. IMPLEMENTATION

4.1 Following the signing of this MoU the parties will negotiate the terms of an agreement to implement the matters set out in this MoU.

4.2 The parties will act in good faith in implementing the terms of the Agreement.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

5.1 The terms of this MoU will not be disclosed by either JNTUK or USFA other than to their professional advisers. However, both parties can display in their web sites if they wish for transparency in administration or authenticity in advertisement.

6. PRACTICAL PART

6.1 The practical part of this degree is to be conducted in West Texas, USA on the campus of USFA. The training required for Conversion of FAA (Federal Aviation Administration of USA) licence to DGCA (Directorate General Civil Aviation Authority of India) licence, will be facilitated by USFA in USA and JNTUK in India. The Academic Training will be done in

Indian JNTUK University, Kakinada. The credit system of JNTUK will be accepted by USFA and the Credit system of USFA will be accepted by JNTUK, Kakinada.

7. LEGAL EFFECT

7.1 The parties agree and confirm that nothing in this MoU will impose any legal obligation on either of them or grant any legal rights or obligations to any party in respect of the other.

8. DURATION OF MoU

8.1 The duration of this MoU is SIX years from the date of signing this agreement by both parties and may be extended by mutual agreement. It shall however be reviewed every year to ensure compliance to the purpose and to make necessary revisions. Either party can terminate this MoU by giving Six Months' notice without incurring any penalties. However, the students already admitted will be taken care of by both the parties even if the Contract is terminated after mutual agreement.

9.0 SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- 9.1 Both parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the MoU through various activities.
- 9.2 Each party will consult with and take approval of the other party to use the latter's name, the names of the latter's officials/faculty members, and the logo for the activities under this MoU, and dissemination of results, on a case-by-case basis.
- 9.3 Modalities of each type of collaboration, associated activities and financial aspects shall be mutually agreed upon on a case-by-case basis in separate Memorandum of Agreements (MoA).
- 9.4 This MoU shall be governed and construed under the laws of the USA and Republic of India depending upon where the activity under this MoU takes place.
- 9.5 The two parties will consult with each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.

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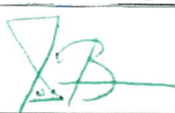

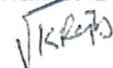

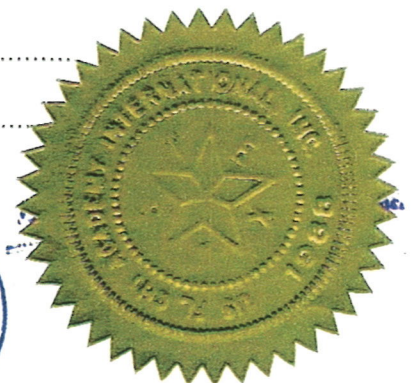
